

**Alabama South Church of the Nazarene**  
***Policy for the District TNU Scholarship Fund for Trevecca***  
***Nazarene University Students***

1. The Alabama South District (ASD) Advisory Board and District Superintendent will establish the policy and procedures for controlling and granting the District Trevecca Nazarene University (TNU) Scholarship Funds. Scholarship monies will be dispersed as they are available through the funds produced by overage of the TNU budget. Overage consists of any funds over 90% giving toward the yearly-allocated TNU budget. All monies are produced through ASD church budgets.
2. The following policy is established:
  - a. The DSF fund will be managed and awarded through the Alabama South District Advisory Board and District Superintendent.
  - b. A list of students from the ASD shall be provided by TNU to be reviewed and approved by the District Superintendent and Advisory Board. Lists are generally provided by October.
  - b. Qualifications:
    - i. The DSF is available to those students of TNU who hold their membership in a ASD church and who have a physical address within the boundaries of the ASD.
    - ii. When a student's parent leaves the district and the student relocates their resident with the parent, the student is no longer eligible for the DSF.
    - iii. Exceptions can be made upon the approval of the Advisory Board and District Superintendent.
  - c. The TSF scholarship will be deemed to be a partial scholarship. A full scholarship to cover 100 percent of college costs is not available. The District Scholarship will be for one year only. Requests for succeeding a DSF scholarship will be evaluated and awarded as determined by the ASD advisory board commensurate with availability of funds.
  - d. The TSF scholarship is only available for undergraduate degrees.
  - d. Amendments to this policy may be made by majority vote of the ASD Advisory Board and District Superintendent.
